ORDINANCE NO. 8 186302

Authorize a contract and provide payment for the construction components of the Carolina Pump Main Phase 2 Project at an estimated cost of \$2,850,000 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- The Water Bureau requires the installation of a 24 inch pump main from the intersection of SW Chestnut Street and SW Burlingame Avenue to the intersection of SW Terwilliger Boulevard and SW Capitol Highway. This pump main will interconnect the Fulton Pump Main and Carolina Pump Main systems. The work involves the installation of approximately 3,400 feet of 24 inch pipe, including 340 feet of jack and bored steel casing pipe, one magnetic meter vault and one intertie vault in the traffic island at the intersection of Capitol Highway and Terwilliger Boulevard.
- 2. The engineer's estimate for this contract action is \$2,850,000 with a high confidence rating.
- 3. Funding of \$350,000 is available in the FY 2013-14 Budget and \$2,500,000 will be requested in the FY 2014-15 Budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. Upon the Council's acceptance of the Chief Procurement Officer's report recommending the lowest responsible bidder, the Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to negotiate and execute a contract, provided the contract has been approved as to form by the City Attorney's office.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver checks chargeable to the Water Fund when demand is presented and approved by the proper authorities.
