#### 7. BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS

October 1, 2013

This Ordinance settles a claim by Western Systems & Fabrication for damages to a street sweeper it owned, but which the Bureau of Transportation was using. The Bureau was considering purchasing this model of street sweeper, and was having operators evaluate it during actual use. On November 1, 2012, the City operator was westbound crossing the Steel Bridge when the rear wheel hub of the sweeper hit the left center curb. The front bumper of the sweeper then struck the bridge guard rail.

The City was responsible for damage to this demonstration sweeper. Due to the specialized nature of the damaged vehicle, cost of repair was substantial, totaling \$12,574.85. Liability on the part of the City is clear, and the amount of damage is not disputed. Risk Management has advanced \$5,000 to Western Systems. This Ordinance will authorize payment of the balance (\$7,574.85), which will fully resolve City Risk Claim No. F2013-5053-01.

#### 8. FINANCIAL IMPACT

Approval of the settlement would result in a payment of \$12,574.85 from the liability fund.

### 9. RECOMMENDATION/ACTION REQUESTED

Approve settlement of Western Systems & Fabrication LLC property damage claim in the sum of \$12,574.85.
