ORDINANCE No. 186325

*Accept and appropriate a grant in the amount of \$50,281 from the Oregon Military Department, Office of Emergency Management for the implementation of state and local homeland security strategies. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council Finds:

- 1. The Portland Bureau of Emergency Management (PBEM) applied to the Oregon Military Department, Office of Emergency Management (OEM) for a grant in the amount of \$279,486 for implementation of state and local homeland security strategies.
- 2. OEM has notified the City of Portland that it will award three separate grants for the implementation of state and local homeland security strategies to PBEM in the total amount of \$50,281. Project costs can be incurred for October 1, 2013 December 31, 2014.
- 3. These funds will be used to:
 - Support continuation of Portland's instance of the WebEOC incident management system, in the amount of \$20,450.00.
 - Support continuation of Multnomah County's community emergency notification system, in the amount of \$25,000.00
 - Support Portland's Community Emergency Response Team/Neighborhood Emergency Team (NET) program, in the amount of \$4,831.00.
 - No match is required by the State Homeland Security Program.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council Directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland three grant awards from OEM for the implementation of state and local homeland security strategies in the amount of \$50,281 and to execute the grant agreements in forms similar to the agreements attached as Exhibit A.
- b. The FY 2013/2014 budget is hereby amended as follows:

<u>GRANTS FUND</u> Fund 217 Business Area – EM Bureau Program Expenses– \$50,281

- c. The Office of Management & Finance Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.
- d. The Director of PBEM is authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland any subsequent modifications by OEM for FY 2013 SHSP grants, award numbers 13-235, 13-236

and 13-237, provided such modifications do not increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk. Any modifications that increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk must be authorized by the Portland City Council.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay would unnecessarily impair the City's ability to perform the activities authorized by the grant. Therefore this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
