

**ORDINANCE No. 186326**

\*Authorize a contract with the lowest responsible bidder for the 102<sup>nd</sup> Avenue: NE Glisan Street to SE Washington Street Phase II project (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Portland Bureau of Transportation (PBOT) received Urban STP funds from Metro in the amount of \$2,445,563 for the 102<sup>nd</sup> Avenue: NE Glisan to SE Washington Phase II Project in 2010.
2. On January 19, 2011, City Council passed Ordinance No. 184371 authorizing PBOT to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement with the Oregon Department of Transportation to receive the \$2,445,563 STP grant.
3. The 102<sup>nd</sup> Avenue: NE Glisan to SE Washington Phase II Project implements the recommendations of the 102nd Avenue Streetscape Plan adopted by City Council on November 9, 2005 by Resolution No. 36345.
4. This project is identified in the City's Capital Improvement Program (CIP).
5. The Bureau of Transportation has funds budgeted in FY 2013-14 and proposed FY 2014-15 for construction, inspection and management of the project.
6. The Bureau's level of confidence in the cost estimate for this project is high as the project scope is clearly understood and well defined.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. Upon the Council's acceptance of the Chief Procurement Officer's report recommending the lowest responsible bidder, the Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to negotiate and execute a contract, provided the contract has been approved as to form by the City Attorney's office.
- b. The Auditor to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to PBOT T00134 when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because it is important to advertise this project as soon as possible to begin construction of pipe work before winter season and periods of high water; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
