ORDINANCE NO. 186328

Authorize application to Oregon Department of Transportation for a 3-year Safe Community Grant in the amount of \$85,000 per year to systematically apply specific engineering, enforcement, education strategies and proven traffic safety countermeasures on identified arterials in Portland. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Oregon Department of Transportation is soliciting projects for grant funding under the Safe Community Grants Program; and
- 2. The program is funding 3-year projects that use engineering, enforcement, and education strategies and research-proven safety countermeasures to reduce the number and severity of traffic crashes; and
- 3. The Bureau of Transportation intends to apply for a grant aimed to systematically apply specific traffic safety engineering, enforcement, and education countermeasures on identified arterials in Portland; and
- 4. Local match in the amount of \$63,750 will be provided by City of Portland's Traffic Safety Account in the form of staff hours, benefits, and engineering improvements in the FY 2013-14 budget of Transportation.

NOW, THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. The Commissioner-in-charge is hereby authorized to make application to the Oregon Department of Transportation for a 3-year Safe Community Grant in the amount of \$85,000 per year.
- b. The Commissioner in charge is authorized to provide such information and assurances as are required for the grant period.
- c. The OMF Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.
