## ORDINANCE No. 186340

Authorize the Bureau of Environmental Services to amend legal descriptions for temporary easements and to acquire said easements for the construction of the Luther Road Habitat Restoration Project No. E06947 through the exercise of the City's Eminent Domain Authority. (Ordinance; amend Ordinance No. 185082 and Ordinance No. 185241)

#### The City of Portland ordains:

#### Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Ordinance No. 185082 passed City Council on December 21, 2011 authorized the Bureau of Environmental Services to acquire certain permanent easements for construction of the Luther Road Habitat Restoration Project No. E06947 through use of the City's Eminent Domain Authority.
- 2. Ordinance No. 185241 passed City Council on April 4, 2012 authorized the Bureau of Environmental Services to acquire certain permanent easements for construction of the Luther Road Habitat Restoration Project No. E06947 through use of the City's Eminent Domain Authority.
- 3. The Bureau of Environmental Services has determined that a Temporary Construction Easement is required over a portion of the property located at 8107 SE Luther Road, Portland, Oregon (also referenced as 12E29AA03300).
- 4. The Bureau of Environmental Services has determined that a Temporary Construction Easement is required over a portion of the property located at 7800 SE Luther Road, Portland, Oregon (also referenced as 12E29AB03500).
- 5. Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FY 2013-2014 Budget, Bureau of Environmental Services, Project No. E06947, Account No. 549000 (temporary non-asset).

### NOW, THEREFORE, the council directs:

- a. The Director of the Bureau of Environmental Services or designee and/or City Attorney are authorized to acquire the necessary temporary easements for the Luther Road Habitat Restoration Project No. E06947 under the Eminent Domain Authority of the City, including filing an action to acquire the property interests described herein or negotiating just compensation with property owners within available project budget funds.
- b. The Director of the Bureau of Environmental Services or designee and/or City Attorney are further authorized to enter into obligations agreements with property owners to address construction management concerns within available project budget funds.

- c. The property affected by this ordinance is described on Exhibits A-1 and A-2 and depicted on Exhibits B-1 and B-2 attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.
- d. The cost incurred in connection with the acquisition herein authorized shall be charged to the Luther Road Habitat Restoration Project No. E06947.
- e. All remaining portions of Ordinance No. 185082 and Ordinance No. 185241 shall remain unchanged and all conditions thereof shall remain in full force and effect.
- f. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the Sewer System Operating Fund Budget when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.
