

ORDINANCE No. 186341

Authorize the contract and provide for payment for construction of Luther Road Habitat Restoration Project No. E06947 for \$3.63 million (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The City owns and maintains the 76-inch Lents Trunkline Sewer. This sewer crosses Johnson Creek near SE 72nd Avenue in Clackamas County and is currently at risk of failure due to the natural migration and down cutting of Johnson Creek.
2. The City plans to partially relocate and restore Johnson Creek to protect the sewer crossing and increase distance to industrial properties. The project will also reconnecting floodplains, create off channel refuge for threatened and endangered species, and treat stormwater from two outfalls. The project also includes an ADA accessible trail system that connects the Springwater trail to the site.
3. The City has prepared plans, specification and cost estimates and obtained permits and right of way for construction of the project.
4. The estimated cost is \$3,630,000. Confidence in this estimate is Optimal. Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating fund, FY14 Budget, WBS Element E06947.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Commissioner in Charge is authorized to execute a contract with the lowest bidder for the purpose described in Section 1.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the Sewer System Operating Fund Budget when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.




