#### 7. BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS

This ordinance will settle a lawsuit brought in State Circuit Court by April Coiteux against the City of Portland for bodily injury and auto value loss suffered when her vehicle was struck by a Portland Police Officer on June 20, 2012. This settlement amount is \$18,006.11. \$10,000 will be paid to Ms. Coiteux and her attorney Tim Quenelle for economic and non-economic damages as well as loss of value on her Subaru. \$6,447.15 will be paid to United States Automobile Association (USAA) in reimbursement of a collision loss payment. \$1,558.96 has already been paid to USAA in medical reimbursement.

#### 8. FINANCIAL IMPACT

Approval of the settlement would result in a payment of \$18,006.11 from the liability fund.
