

ORDINANCE NO. 186363

Authorize a contract and provide payment for the construction components of the Bertha Service Area Improvements Project at an estimated cost of \$650,000 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Water Bureau requires the installation of 8 inch and 4 inch mains (approximately 2,250 feet and 370 feet, respectively) from the intersection of SW Westwood Drive and SW 14th Avenue south to SW Westwood Court, west to the intersection of SW Martha Street and SW 18th Drive and north to the service for 5104 SW 18th Drive. In addition, the Water Bureau requires the installation of 6 inch by 2 inch regulator vault near the intersection of SW 18th Place and SW 18th Drive.
2. The engineer's estimate for this contract action is \$650,000 with a high confidence rating.
3. Funding of \$97,500 is available in the FY 2013-14 Budget and \$552,500 will be requested in the FY 2014-15 Budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. Upon the Council's acceptance of the Chief Procurement Officer's report recommending the lowest responsible bidder, the Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to negotiate and execute a contract, provided the contract has been approved as to form by the City Attorney's office.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver checks chargeable to the Water Fund when demand is presented and approved by the proper authorities.


