ORDINANCE NO. 186367

* Authorize a grant agreement with VOZ Workers' Rights Education Project for \$25,000 to operate and maintain their Portland Day Labor Hire Site (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Day Laborers Project began in 1996 as a project of the Worker's Organizing Committee (WOC); and
- 2. VOZ opened the Portland Day Labor Hire Site on June 16, 2008. It has been an important community institution offering a safe and healthy place for workers while they wait for work. The Day Labor Hire Site also provides accountability to employers and protects workers from exploitation; and
- 3. VOZ has continued to mobilize its memberships to secure and promote their rights through organizing, leadership development, and community education; and
- 4. The FY 2013-14 budget includes funding in the General Fund Special Appropriations for the above grant. The City now desires to make a grant to VOZ Workers' Rights Education Project in an amount not to exceed \$25,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is authorized to enter into a Grant Agreement, as outlined in form substantially in accordance with the agreement attached as Exhibit A, at a cost not to exceed \$25,000.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver payment chargeable to the Fiscal Year 2013-14 Budget.
- Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists in order to avoid a delay in providing support to the operation of the Portland Labor Hire Site; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
