The USDOJ will reimburse the City a maximum of \$325,000 to fund program expenses, including two 0.70 FTE's (Regional Administrator and Assistant Regional Administrator), travel, program supplies, and intra-agency expenses required to operate the G.R.E.A.T. Region program.
