There is no direct cost to create the new classification. Three regular positions will be reclassified to the new classification. One is a Principal Information Systems Analyst (PISA) which has a maximum rate of \$104, 291. Two are Information Systems Technical Analysts (ISTA) VI which has a maximum rate of \$92,872. The annual increase for the PISA position will be \$4,181 and for the ISTA VI positions the annual increase for each is \$15,600.

The total annual increase at maximum based on the interim rates for all three positions is \$35,381.

7. <u>BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS</u>

The Bureau of Technology Services (BTS) requested the creation of a new classification of Information Security Architect in order to describe the specific duties of three positions responsible for contributing to the design of the City software and infrastructure security architecture. The Information Security Architects will focus on security design, policy recommendation, and security audit compliance.

The Bureau of Human Resources is recommending an interim salary range with a minimum rate of \$39.15 and a maximum rate of \$52.15. Annual equivalents are \$81,432 and \$108,472. The final salary range must be bargained with the City of Portland Professional Employees Association (COPPEA).

There is no direct cost to create the new classification. Three regular positions will be reclassified to the new classification. One is a Principal Information Systems Analyst (PISA) which has a maximum rate of \$104, 291. Two are Information Systems Technical Analysts (ISTA) VI which has a maximum rate of \$92,872. The annual increase for the PISA position will be \$4,181 and for the ISTA VI positions the annual increase for each is \$15,600.

The total annual increase at maximum based on the interim rates for all three positions is \$35,381.
