ORDINANCE No.

*Authorize a grant agreement with Lifeworks Northwest for \$70,000 to provide additional resources for the New Options for Women program (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council Finds:

- 1. At least 469 children were exploited as commercial sex workers in Portland between 2009 and 2013 according to a 2013 study by Portland State University commissioner by US Attorney Amanda Marshall.
- 2. Twenty seven percent (27%) of the exploited children were African-American, a percentage five times greater than the percentage of African Americans in Multnomah County.
- 3. Many more women, men and transgender individuals over the age of 18 are forced into prostitution in Portland, which has received national attention as a hub for human trafficking.
- 4. Nearly one in 25 men in Portland solicited sex for pay online in a 24 hour period, according to a 2013 Arizona State University study.
- 5. Portland was ranked second in the nation in rescued child survivors of human trafficking, according to a 2010 study highlighted by Dan Rather on 60 minutes.
- 6. The City of Portland cut funding for services to victims of human trafficking by \$117,000 in the FY 2013-14 Adopted Budget.
- 7. Of the many life-and-death needs in Portland, assistance to youth and young adults age 18 -25 wishing to escape from the slavery of human trafficking is among the most urgent.
- 8. Providers report that both boys and girls are entering the path to sexual exploitation as early as middle school. Additional education targeted to vulnerable populations in high-risk middle schools would provide children with the training they need to promote healthy behavior and reduce the risk of human trafficking.
- 9. The NOW program provides services to women and girls who have been commercially, sexually exploited.
- 10. NOW utilizes Sexual Assault Resource Center (SARC) referrals of 18-25 year old women who are victims of commercial sexual exploitation.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is authorized to execute a grant agreement with Lifeworks Northwest in the amount of \$70,000 to provide for additional clinical services for the New Options for Women program.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver payment chargeable to the Fiscal Year 2013-14 Budget.

Section 2. The council declares that an emergency exists because a delay in funding could impact Lifeworks Northwest's ability to provide services to women who are victims of commercial sexual exploitation; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and in effect after its passage by council.
