## ORDINANCE NO. 186390

\* Authorize a combined total of \$1,938,209 in additional funding for three subrecipient contracts to help end homelessness for vulnerable adults and families (Ordinance; amend Ordinance No. 186168 and Contract Nos. 30003459, 32000965 and 32000967)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds that:

- On November 13, 2013, the Portland City Council voted to direct \$1,700,000 of City General Fund to help end homelessness for vulnerable adults and families. Prior budget revision directs \$100,000 to JOIN for Women Into Housing Now (WIHN) to get women who are experiencing homelessness into housing. Council adopted an IGA with Multnomah County for outreach in East Multnomah County for \$138,209. These funds will be contracted with JOIN.
- 2. The City of Portland, acting through its Portland Housing Bureau has been a major funder of the key strategies and services of the Plan to End Homelessness.
- 3. The Portland Housing Bureau (PHB) will amend existing contracts to direct these funds for housing placement and services to organizations serving adults and families experiencing homelessness. More than 300 households will move from the streets or shelters to stable homes, including 100 families and 200 individuals.
- 4. Funded programs and services have a demonstrated record of success and effectiveness in moving our community towards the bigger goal of ending homelessness.
- 5. It is the Portland Housing Bureau's intent to continue funding successful and effective existing programs at the funding levels identified in Exhibit A that exceed \$100,000.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council directs that:

- a. The Bureau Director and City Auditor are authorized to execute the agreement amendments with the organizations and for the amounts, identified in Exhibit A, for the purpose described above.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the Portland Housing Bureau's operating fund budget when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because the program funds must be obligated within required timeframes; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
