

ORDINANCE No. 186409

*Authorize application to East Multnomah Soil and Water Conservation District for a grant in the amount of \$60,000 for Crystal Springs Culverts Removal and Habitat Restoration (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. Water quality and watershed management is a key part of the mission of the Bureau of Environmental Services in particular.
2. In 2007, the Bureau launched efforts to remove and/or repair nine fish barrier culverts in Crystal Springs as the top priority for replacement.
3. East Multnomah Soil and Water Conservation District (EMSWCD) funds projects that improve habitat and watershed health through their Partners in Conservation (PIC) program. BES is preparing a grant application to submit to EMSWCD requesting funds in the amount of \$60,000 for culvert removal and habitat restoration at the Glenwood and Bybee culverts, two of nine fish barrier culverts along Crystal Springs.
4. Local match in the amount of \$60,000 will be provided in the form of salary, benefits and external services in the FY 2013/14 budget and FY 2014/15 proposed budget of the Bureau of Environmental Services. Matching funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, Bureau of Environmental Services, WBS element E10480.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to make an application to EMSWCD for a grant in the amount of \$60,000.
- b. The Mayor is authorized to provide such information and assurances as are required for the grant period.
- c. The OMF Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists since the application must be delivered by January 16, 2014. Therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
