

ORDINANCE No. 186413

* Accept and appropriate a grant in the amount of \$15,000 from the Oregon Department of Transportation, Transportation Safety Division for the 2014 Speed (Multi-Unit Traffic Enforcement) Grant Program for sworn personnel overtime (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) has notified the City that it will award a grant for the 2014 Speed (Multi-Unit Traffic Enforcement) Grant Program to the Police Bureau in the amount of \$15,000; and
2. The ODOT project will fund overtime for the Police Bureau's Traffic Division to provide enhanced multi-unit traffic enforcement patrols at ODOT-determined top sites with speed-involved crashes. A second priority of these enforcement patrols may be texting and cell phone use while driving; and
3. ODOT will reimburse the City a maximum of \$15,000 for sworn personnel overtime hours worked on the 2014 Speed (Multi-Unit Traffic Enforcement) Grant Program during the grant period October 1, 2013, through September 30, 2014; and
4. Local match in the amount of \$3,756 shall be provided from City funds in the form of Traffic Division straight time hours in the Bureau's FY 2013-14 appropriated budget; and
5. The Council declares an emergency exists because a delay would jeopardize the awarding of the grant funds from ODOT.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City a grant from ODOT for the 2014 Speed (Multi-Unit Traffic Enforcement) Grant Program in the amount of \$15,000.
- b. The FY 2013-14 budget is hereby amended as follows:

GRANTS FUND

Fund - 217

Business Area - PL

Bureau Program Expenses - \$15,000


- c. The Office of Management & Finance Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.
- d. The Chief of the Police Bureau of the City of Portland is authorized to accept on behalf of the City any subsequent modifications by ODOT for the 2014 Speed (Multi-Unit Traffic Enforcement) Grant Program, SC-14-35-11 PPB, provided such modifications do not increase the City's financial obligation or risk. Any modifications that increase the City's financial obligation or risk must be authorized by the Portland City Council.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay would jeopardize the awarding of the grant funds from ODOT. Therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
