## ORDINANCE No. 186414

\*Pay claim of Lisa Beasley in the sum of \$24,423, involving the Portland Police Bureau. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

## Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Lisa Beasley, through her attorney, Stephen Riedlinger, has filed a bodily injury lawsuit against the City for damages suffered in an incident occurring on October 28, 2010. In the lawsuit, claimant makes claim for motor vehicle accident involving the Portland Police Bureau.
- 2. The claim has been investigated by Risk Management Services. The investigation indicates there is risk the City may be found liable. Therefore, in order to avoid the risk of an adverse jury award, we feel it is prudent to compromise the lawsuit at this time.
- 3. Risk Management Services recommends the lawsuit be compromised for the total sum of \$24,423.08, subject to the claimant providing the City with a release in a form to be approved by the City Attorney. Risk has already resolved the auto insurance PIP subrogation for medical expenses of \$9,423.00 in arbitration.

## NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor and the Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver a check in the amount of \$15,000.00 made payable to Lisa Beasley and Susak & Powell. Added to the \$9,423.00 already paid, the total value of the claim settlement is \$24,423.08.
- b. Risk Management Services will execute a payment authorization in the amount set forth in sub-paragraph (a) above.
- Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists in order to avoid undue and costly delay in settling this lawsuit; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
