## ORDINANCE No.

\* Accept and appropriate a grant in the amount of \$4,554,394 from the Federal Emergency Management Agency for the 2013 Staffing for Adequate Fire and Emergency Response Grant (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds

- 1. Portland Fire & Rescue (PF&R) applied to the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) for a grant in the amount of \$4,554,394 for the 2013 Staffing for Adequate Fire and Emergency Response (SAFER) Grant Program on August 22, 2013; and
- 2. FEMA has notified the City of Portland that it will award a grant for the 2013 SAFER Grant to PF&R in the amount of \$4,554,394; and
- 3. The grant requires that staffing at the level that existed at the time of the award, as well as the SAFER funded staffing, be maintained for the two-year SAFER grant period of performance. Laying off-firefighters during the two-year grant period of performance will result in termination of the grant award.
- 4. The FY 2013 SAFER Award Package is attached hereto as Exhibit A.

NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland a grant from the Federal Emergency Management AGENCY for the 2013 SAFER Grant in the amount of \$4,554,394 and to execute the grant agreement.
- b. The FY 2013/2014 budget is hereby amended as follows:

## **GRANTS FUND**

Fund 217

Business Area – FR

Bureau Program Expenses – \$1,200,000

- c. The Office of Management & Finance Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.
- d. The Fire Chief of PF&R, of the City of Portland is authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland any subsequent modifications by FEMA for the 2013 SAFER Grant Program, EMW-2013-FH-00077, provided such modifications do not increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk. Any modifications that increase the

City of Portland's financial obligation or risk must b

City of Portland's financial obligation or risk must be authorized by the Portland City Council.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay would unnecessarily delay the City's ability to perform the activities authorized by the grant. Therefore this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
