

## ORDINANCE No. 186417

Authorize a contract for construction of the Rose City Park Sewer Rehabilitation Project No. E10345, for \$6,410,000 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. Approximately 20,000 feet of combined and sanitary sewer pipe in the Rose City Park neighborhood between NE Fremont St, Interstate 84, NE 73<sup>rd</sup> Ave, and NE 55<sup>th</sup> Ave are in a severely deteriorated condition and need to be replaced or rehabilitated.
2. Environmental Services has prepared plans and specifications for replacing or rehabilitating the deteriorated sewer pipe including sewer manholes and service laterals.
3. The estimated cost is \$6,410,000. Level of confidence in this estimate is high. Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FY 2014, budget, Bureau of Environmental Services, WBS Element E10345.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Commissioner in Charge is authorized to execute a contract for the purpose described in Section 1, with the lowest responsive bidder.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the Sewer System Operating Fund Budget when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.


