7. BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS

This ordinance is to settle a tort claim against the City resulting from an auto collision that occurred on February 15, 2013, at SE 60th and Flavel. That intersection is controlled by a 4-way stop. The claimant, Yairsa Gonzalez, was a passenger in a vehicle that was southbound on SE 60th. The Gonzalez car stopped at SE Flavel, then started into the intersection. A City of Portland Parks Bureau pickup truck eastbound on SE Flavel failed to stop at the intersection, colliding with the Gonzalez car. The City driver was cited at the scene for failure to obey a traffic control device, and did not contest the citation.

Liability on the part of the City is clear. State Farm made a reimbursement claim against the City for medical expenses it had paid on behalf of Ms. Gonzalez. Risk Management negotiated a reduced settlement with State Farm for \$3,744.85. After significant settlement negotiations with her attorney, Risk Management has reached the proposed settlement of \$10,000 for the "pain and suffering" part of her claim, resulting in a total settlement for this claimant of \$13,744.85.

8. FINANCIAL IMPACT

Approval of the settlement would result in an aditional payment of \$10,000 from the liability fund.

9. RECOMMENDATION/ACTION REQUESTED

Approve settlement of Yairsa Gonzalez bodily injury claim in the sum of \$13,744.85.
