

ORDINANCE NO. 186424

* Authorize Intergovernmental Agreement with Multnomah County, Environmental Health Services Department to support Healthy Homes activities (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

SECTION 1. The Council finds that:

1. The Multnomah County Health Department (MCHD) was awarded a \$1,000,000 three year Healthy Homes grant from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development to assess and correct housing-related environmental health and safety hazards that may contribute to illness, injury, or adverse health outcomes for vulnerable populations such as children or elderly.
2. The Portland Housing Bureau (PHB) is committed to working collaboratively with MCHD to address the connection between health and housing and its impacts low-income households.
3. PHB is providing resources in the amount of \$26,000 in Community Development Block Grant dollars to MCHD to increase their ability to provide these services.


NOW THEREFORE, the Council directs that:

- a. The Bureau Director and City Auditor are hereby authorized to execute agreements with the County in the amounts described above substantially in accordance with the intergovernmental agreement attached as Exhibit A.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the PHB operating fund budget when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.

SECTION 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because delay in funding would interrupt the ability of the Multnomah County Health Department to provide assistance and services to low-income households; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.


