ORDINANCE No. 186426

*Authorize Intergovernmental Agreement with Oregon Department of Transportation for the right of way phase of the SE Holgate & SE Ramona: 122nd to 136th Avenue Sidewalks project. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Portland Bureau of Transportation applied for a Transportation Enhancement (TE) Grant in the amount of \$1,487,000 on September of 2010 for the SE Holgate & SE Ramona: 122nd to 136th Avenue Sidewalks project.
2. The City Council passed Ordinance No. 185317, dated May 16, 2012, approving the Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) to receive the grant from Oregon Department of Transportation.
3. This Intergovernmental Agreement is to allow the City of Portland to do the right-of-way phase of the project.
4. The Bureau's level of confidence in the cost estimates for this project is low. The cost estimate for the design and construction will be developed during the design phase.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Commissioner-in-Charge is hereby authorized to execute an IGA, approved as to form by the City Attorney, with the Oregon Department of Transportation for the right-of-way phase of the SE Holgate & SE Ramona: 122nd to 136th Avenue Sidewalks project, in a form similar to the contract attached as Exhibit A.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay would unnecessarily delay the City's ability to perform the activities authorized by the intergovernmental agreement; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.


