Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Bureau of Environmental Services (BES) has need of continuing professional engineering services by Brown and Caldwell, Inc. (B&C) during the construction and startup/closeout phases of the Ankeny pump station Upgrade project.
- 2. B&C is continuing to provide professional engineering services under Contract No. 30000768 effective October 26, 2011 with an expiration date of October 4, 2014.
