ORDINANCE No. 186434

Authorize a contract and provide for payment for the construction of the Grant Park Sewer Rehabilitation Project No. E10346 for \$3,570,000 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Approximately 11,500 feet of combined and sanitary sewer pipe is to be replaced or rehabilitated in the Grant Park neighborhood between NE Stanton St., NE 33rd Ave., I-84 and NE 24th Ave. These sewers are in severely deteriorated condition and need to be replaced or rehabilitated.
- 2. Environmental Services has prepared plans and specifications for replacing or rehabilitating the deteriorated sewer pipe including sewer manholes and service laterals.
- 3. The estimated cost is \$3,570,000. Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FY 2014 Budget. Bureau of Environmental Services, WBS Element E10346.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Commissioner in Charge is authorized to execute a contract with the lowest responsive bidder for the purpose described in Section 1.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the Sewer System Operating Fund Budget when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.
