

ORDINANCE No. 186434

Authorize a contract and provide for payment for the construction of the Grant Park Sewer Rehabilitation Project No. E10346 for \$3,570,000 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. Approximately 11,500 feet of combined and sanitary sewer pipe is to be replaced or rehabilitated in the Grant Park neighborhood between NE Stanton St., NE 33rd Ave., I-84 and NE 24th Ave. These sewers are in severely deteriorated condition and need to be replaced or rehabilitated.
2. Environmental Services has prepared plans and specifications for replacing or rehabilitating the deteriorated sewer pipe including sewer manholes and service laterals.
3. The estimated cost is \$3,570,000. Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FY 2014 Budget. Bureau of Environmental Services, WBS Element E10346.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Commissioner in Charge is authorized to execute a contract with the lowest responsive bidder for the purpose described in Section 1.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the Sewer System Operating Fund Budget when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.


