1. Background

The Hoyt Arboretum and Herbarium in partnership with Leach Botanical Garden, both holdings of Portland Parks & Recreation, seeks the Museums for America - Collections Stewardship Grant for the amount of \$67,521 to support two years of living collections stewardship including plant species inventory, vouchering, species determination, improved archival environment for vouchers, digitizing of vouchers and photographing living collections. Quality stewardship allows for effective collections evaluations, informed planting plans accurate plant labels and interpretive panels. This grant will strengthen our ability to provide resources to the general population as well as researchers; we intend this collections stewardship to be the foundation for building strong future programs in outreach, education and research, both locally and globally. Starting in 2010, Hoyt, for the first time since its creation in 1927, began conducting a collections review including determination and vouchering of 135 families, 1,391 species, over 7,800 individuals. Leach, for the first time since its opening in 1983, in partnership with Hoyt, will continue a first time collections review that started in 2010 as well, including determination and vouchering of their approximately 1,000 species, 7,000 individuals.
