

# ORDINANCE No. 186457

Authorize a contract and provide for payment for the construction of the SE Clinton-Caruthers System Improvements Project No. E08662 for \$2,480,000 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Bureau of Environmental Services has a need to construct the SE Clinton-Caruthers System Improvements Project in SE Portland. 24 green street facilities and two blocks of pervious pavement need to be installed to improve stormwater management and watershed health. Approximately 3,800 feet of new combined sewer pipe needs to be constructed to provide standard sewer service to existing properties.
2. The Bureau of Environmental Services has prepared plans and specifications to add new stormwater facilities and replacing undersized combined sewer pipes. The Bureau of Environmental Services requires the furnishing of materials and labor for this project.
3. The estimated cost is \$2,480,000. Level of confidence is optimal. Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FY 2013-14 Budget, Bureau of Environmental Services, WBS Element E08662.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Commissioner in Charge is authorized to execute a contract with lowest responsible bidder for the purpose described in Section 1.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the Sewer System Operating Fund Budget when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.
