

ORDINANCE No. 186460

Amend Intergovernmental Agreement with the State of Oregon, Office of the State Fire Marshal, for Regional Hazardous Materials Emergency Response Team Services.
(Ordinance; amend Contract No. 30003647)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. On November 20, 2013, Council passed Ordinance No 186344 authorizing an agreement with the State of Oregon, Office of the State Fire Marshall for Regional Hazardous Materials Emergency Response Team.
2. Exhibit G – Extraordinary Response Cost Fee Schedule – Compensation for Contractor's Response Personnel has been updated to more accurately reflect current compensation rates for HazMat Team Members.
3. The Fire Chief recommends that the City execute this Amendment, and states that participation on the Regional Hazardous Materials Team will not impair the ability of PF&R to protect the citizens of Portland.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. That the Commissioner of Public Affairs and the City Auditor are authorized to execute Amendment No. 1 to Contract 30003647, substantially in accordance with Exhibit A, attached hereto.

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

