## ORDINANCE No. 186472

Accept a grant in the amount of \$1,524,546 from the Portland Development Commission and authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement for the construction of the Streetcar Relocation Project (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

## Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. On December 15, 2010, Council passed Ordinance No. 184300, accepting a grant in the amount of \$1,958,651 from the Oregon Department of Transportation ConnectOregon III program, and authorizing a grant agreement for the Streetcar Relocation Project to build a dual streetcar track and improve operations for the Streetcar (the "Project").
- 2. The original alignment crossed the site of the future Oregon Sustainability Center (OSC). When the OSC development did not move forward, the project team worked with stakeholders to determine a new alignment for the needed double track segment. The new alignment is in the existing SW Montgomery and SW 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue public street right of-way.
- 3. This Agreement provides for \$1,524,546 in Tax Increment funding for the design and construction of the new streetcar alignment from the Portland Development Commission.
- 4. Project construction is anticipated in summer of 2014.
- 5. The Bureau of Transportation and the Portland Development Commission have TR000189 as an existing grant agreement for this project.

## NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Commissioner-in-Charge is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland a grant from the Portland Development Commission for the Streetcar Relocation Project in the amount of \$1,524,546.00 and execute an Intergovernmental Agreement in a form similar to the contract attached as Exhibit A.
- b. The Commissioner-in-Charge is authorized to execute amendments, approved as to form by the City Attorney, to the scope of the services or the terms and conditions of this Agreement, provided the changes do not increase the City's financial risk. Increases to the grant amount must be approved by the City Council.
- c. The OMF Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Commissioner-in-Charge's behalf.
