

ORDINANCE No. 186475

* Authorize contract and provide for payment for Uniformed Security Officer Services at an estimated cost of \$5,000,000 for a five year contract. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Uniformed Security Officer Services for the Bureau of Internal Business Services are estimated to be \$5,000,000 for a five year contract. The estimate is within the program budget.
2. The contract term will be five years.
3. The Request for Proposals has been prepared and is ready to issue.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Chief Procurement Officer and Auditor are hereby authorized to execute a contract with the highest scoring proposer for Uniformed Security Officer Services for the Bureau of Internal Business Services in accordance with the specifications filed with the Chief Procurement Officer.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver checks chargeable to the appropriate fund when demand is presented and approved by the proper authorities.


Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists in order to avoid a lapse in services; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
