ORDINANCE No. 186479

Authorize revenue generating Intergovernmental Agreement with Metro in the amount of \$20,000 for the development of a weed treatment calendar (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The City of Portland and Metro share goals of improving watershed health in the Portland-Metro area and surrounding watersheds, and would benefit from partnerships to accomplish our goals.
- 2. On March 8, 2006, the Council adopted the 2005 Portland Watershed Management Plan, which describes actions for watershed health including reducing populations of non-native plants and organisms to levels that do not compete with native species.
- 3. ORS 190.003-190.110 encourages intergovernmental cooperation. Metro has requested the assistance of BES to develop a best management practices weed treatment calendar per terms established in the attached Intergovernmental Agreement and will reimburse all direct and indirect costs incurred by BES.
- 3. The established revenue is not to exceed \$20,000. Payments will be deposited into the Sewer System Operating Fund and credited to the Invasive Species Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Director of the Bureau of Environmental Services is authorized to execute an Intergovernmental Agreement with Metro for the purpose described in Section 1, in the amount of \$20,000.
- b. The Director of the Bureau of Environmental Services is authorized to execute amendments to this agreement.
