TO THE COUNCIL:

The Chief Procurement Officer has advertised and received bids for Bid Number 116295 for the Carolina Pump Main Phase 2 Project for the Portland Water Bureau, with a project construction estimate of \$2,850,000.00. The Portland Water Bureau rated the project estimate confidence level as High.

Bids were opened on January 28, 2014, and Five (5) bids were received. The low bid of Tapani, Inc. was deemed responsive to the requirements of the solicitation, and it is recommended that their bid be accepted at the unit price quoted in their bid for a total estimated amount of \$2,398,324.50.

The Portland Water Bureau along with Procurement Services identified Thirteen (13) Divisions of Work as potential M/W/ESB subcontracting opportunities for this project, resulting in \$707,814.00 awarded to subcontractors.

The Divisions of Work identified were:

MWESB participation represents 39.8% or \$282,000.00 of the estimated subcontracting dollars.

• WBE - \$20,000.00 performing Hauling Services (Trucking)

• ESB - \$8,000.00 performing Landscaping

Tapani, Inc. has a current City of Portland Business Tax Registration and their EEO Certification is current through July 10, 2015. The company is located in Battle Ground, Washington, and is not a State Certified M/W/ESB Contractor.

Tapani, Inc. is in Full Compliance with the Equal Benefits Program.

Funding of \$350,000 is available in the FY 2013-14 Budget and \$2,500,000 will be requested in the FY 2014-15 Budget.

This project has \$690,000 budgeted for FY 2013-14 and is part of the Distribution Mains Program which has a total program budget of \$15,800,000 for FY 2013-14.

It is further recommended that a Performance Bond and a Payment Bond each in the amount of 100% of the contract amount be furnished by the Contractor.

It is also recommended that a two (2) year Maintenance/Warranty Bond for 20% of the final contract amount be furnished by the Contractor before final payment is released.

The bid sureties of the remaining bidders should be returned immediately in compliance with Section 5.34.410D of the City Code.
