

ORDINANCE No.

186492

*Pay claim of Bach Nguyen in the sum of \$18,245 involving the Portland Fire Bureau.
(Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. Bach Nguyen has filed a bodily injury claim against the City for damages suffered in a motor vehicle accident involving the Portland Fire Bureau on September 19, 2012.
2. The claim has been investigated by Risk Management Services. The investigation indicates there is risk the City may be found liable. Therefore, in order to avoid the risk of an adverse jury award, we feel it is prudent to compromise the claim at this time.
3. Risk Management Services recommends the claim be compromised for the total sum of \$18,245.92, subject to the claimant providing the City with a release in a form to be approved by the City Attorney.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor and the Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver a check in the amount of \$9,000 made payable to Bach Nguyen and Kyle Dukelow, Attorney at Law. A second check in the amount of \$9,245.92 will be issued made payable to Farmers Insurance Group.
- b. Risk Management Services will execute a payment authorization in the amount set forth in sub-paragraph (a) above.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists in order to avoid undue and costly delay in settling this claim; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.


