7. BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS

This Ordinance settles a claim against the City by Bach Nguyen for the sum of \$18,245.92. This claim arose from an automobile collision on September 19, 2012, at the intersection of NE 122 and NE Fremont A Fire Bureau employee in a city-owned vehicle went through a red light and struck the claimant who was traveling with the right of way.

Ms. Nguyen was injured and obtained medical treatment following the collision. This settlement resolves claims for both the medical expenses and her noneconomic ("pain and suffering") damages.

8. FINANCIAL IMPACT

Approval of the settlement would result in a payment of \$18,245.92 from the liability fund.
