## ORDINANCE No. 186495

Authorize a contract and provide for payment for the construction of the Inner NE Sanitary Sewer Extension Project No. E10205 for \$1,100,000 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

## Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Approximately 3,100 feet of sanitary sewer pipe is to be constructed in an area of Inner NE Portland neighborhoods bounded by NE 6<sup>th</sup> Ave east to NE 17<sup>th</sup> Ave and NE Mason St north to NE Wygant Street. The existing sewers serving these properties are considered nonconforming, and require replacement by direct public sewer services built to current standards.
- 2. Environmental Services has prepared plans and specifications for constructing new sewer pipe including sewer manholes and service laterals.
- 3. The estimated cost is \$1,100,000. Level of confidence is high. Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FY14 & FY15 Budget, Bureau of Environmental Services, WBS Element E10205.

## NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Commissioner in Charge is authorized to execute a contract with [contractor] for the purpose described in Section 1, with the lowest responsive bidder.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the Sewer System Operating Fund Budget when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.
