

## ORDINANCE No. 186496

Authorize a contract and provide for payment for the construction of the Kenton Sewer Rehabilitation Project No. E10357 for \$2,550,000 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. Approximately 7,000 feet of combined and sanitary sewer pipe is to be replaced or rehabilitated in the Kenton neighborhood between N. Argyle St, N. Lombard St., I-5 Fwy, and N. Delaware Ave. These pipes are in severely deteriorated condition and need to be replaced or rehabilitated.
2. Environmental Services has prepared plans and specifications for replacing or rehabilitating the deteriorated sewer pipe including sewer manholes and service laterals.
3. The estimated cost is \$2,550,000. Level of confidence is high. Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FY 2014, 2015, & 2016 Budgets, Bureau of Environmental Services, WBS Element E10357.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Commissioner in Charge is authorized to execute a contract with [contractor] for the purpose described in Section 1, with the lowest responsive bidder.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the Sewer System Operating Fund Budget when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.




