## ORDINANCE No. 186496

Authorize a contract and provide for payment for the construction of the Kenton Sewer Rehabilitation Project No. E10357 for \$2,550,000 (Ordinance)

### The City of Portland ordains:

#### Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Approximately 7,000 feet of combined and sanitary sewer pipe is to be replaced or rehabilitated in the Kenton neighborhood between N. Argyle St, N. Lombard St., I-5 Fwy, and N. Delaware Ave. These pipes are in severely deteriorated condition and need to be replaced or rehabilitated.
- 2. Environmental Services has prepared plans and specifications for replacing or rehabilitating the deteriorated sewer pipe including sewer manholes and service laterals.
- 3. The estimated cost is \$2,550,000. Level of confidence is high. Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FY 2014, 2015, & 2016 Budgets, Bureau of Environmental Services, WBS Element E10357.

#### NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Commissioner in Charge is authorized to execute a contract with [contractor] for the purpose described in Section 1, with the lowest responsive bidder.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the Sewer System Operating Fund Budget when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.
