ORDINANCE No. 186502

*Accept a grant in the amount of \$2,635,000 from the Oregon Department of Transportation and authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement for the design and construction of the Burgard/Lombard at North Time Oil Road project. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. On August 17, 2011, the Portland City Council passed Resolution No. 36876, as Amended, nominating the Burgard/Lombard at North Time Oil Road Intersection Improvement project for FY 2014-15 Regional Flexible Funds.
- 2. The Portland Bureau of Transportation applied for a Transportation Enhancement (TE) Grant in the amount of \$2,635,000 on September of 2011 for the Burgard/Lombard at North Time Oil Road project.
- 3. Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) has notified the City of Portland that it will award a grant for the Burgard/Lombard at North Time Oil Road project to the Portland Bureau of Transportation in the amount of \$2,635,000.
- 4. This funding is included in the Portland Bureau of Transportation's FY 13-14 Adopted Budget under Grant ID# TR000223.
- 5. The Bureau's level of confidence in the cost estimates for this project is low. The cost estimate for the design and construction will be developed during the design phase.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Commissioner-in-Charge is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland a grant from the Oregon Department of Transportation for the Burgard/Lombard at North Time Oil Road project in the amount of \$2,635,000 and to execute an Intergovernmental Agreement in a form similar to the contract attached as Exhibit A.
- b. The Commissioner-in-Charge is authorize to execute amendments, approved as to form by the City Attorney, to the scope of the services or the terms and conditions of this Agreement, provided that the changes do not increase the City's financials risk. Increases to the grant amount must be approved by the City Council.
- c. The OMF Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents in the Commissioner-in-Charge's behalf.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay would unnecessarily delay the City's ability to perform the activities authorized by the intergovernmental agreement; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
