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ORDINANCE No. 186502

Authorize a contract with the lowest responsible bidder for the S.E. 136th Ave Phase 2: Holgate to Foster Sidewalk Infill Project (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. In 2012, the Portland Bureau of Transportation (PBOT) began work to identify, design and construct sidewalk infill on busier streets carrying transit in East Portland.
2. PBOT has based the prioritization of the projects on East Portland In Motion plans which were adopted by City Council.
3. PBOT began design work on S.E. 136th Ave Phase 2: Holgate to Foster and conducted outreach to property owners and residents.
4. The Bureau of Transportation has funds budgeted in FY 13-14 for construction, inspection and management of the project.
5. The Bureau's level of confidence in the cost estimate for this project is medium because the project is defined and engineering plans and specifications are at 90% design.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. Upon the Council's acceptance of the Chief Procurement Officer's report recommending the lowest responsible bidder, the Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to negotiate and execute a contract, provided the contract has been approved as to form by the City Attorney's office.
- b. The Auditor to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to T00395 when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.
