7. BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS

This ordinance authorizes an amendment, Exhibit A attached, to the contract to add \$706,212 to the Contract value. This amendment will extend the contract two months through May 31, 2014 to allow for continuation of uniformed security officer services. The Contractor was competitively awarded their current price agreement in September 2005 after receiving the highest evaluated points. They have performed well under this price agreement and have consistently offered excellent pricing and service.

The City of Portland provides safe and secure facilities for its employees and visitors. To continue doing so the City has the need for high level professional unarmed and armed security within its many Bureaus, facilities and locations.

An RFP has been issued to request proposals from security firms for the award of a new contract to be effective June 1, 2014. Until a new contract is in effect, it is necessary to continue providing services under the existing contract.

This amendment includes:

- a. Services for April and May in the amount of \$260,000.
- b. Additional services per attached Exhibit A in the amount of \$22,429.
- c. Additional funds in the amount of \$423,783 for services through March are necessary due to the following:

During the 2013-14 budget development process, one of the budget cuts was in regards to the security package. This cut was taken through the budget process and adopted into the FY 2013-14 budget. The Contractor submitted their proposal based on these cuts. After the budget was adopted, a significant increase in services were added. There was not a request to add money to the budget through the bump process.

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8. FINANCIAL IMPACT

This amendment for uniformed security officer services will increase the contract amount by \$706,212. This will bring the new Contract total value to \$12,172,214.37 over a period of eight years and nine months. Contract effective date was September 6, 2005.

The total cost of this amendment is included in the Facilities budget for fiscal years 2013-14. The cost of the security services provided under this contract are charged to the Bureaus directly or recovered through the location rental rates.

9. RECOMMENDATION/ACTION REQUESTED

It is recommended that Council approve this amendment to Contract No. 40997 with G4S Secure Solutions USA, Inc. to provide for uniformed security officer services.
