7. BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS

Water Bureau personnel initially responded to the Envoy location in September, 2013, due to reports of water leaking in the area of a fire hydrant near the condominiums. A repair crew was able to locate the areas of leakage, and excavated in two locations to make repairs. During one of the excavations, they encountered a sewer lateral line that they thought was an abandoned line. They dug through that line in making the water main repair.

On October 12, 2013, there was a sewer backup in the Envoy's laundry room area. City crews responded, and determined that the sewer lateral line that Water Bureau crews had damaged in their main repair work was actually a "live" line, rather than an abandoned line. City maintenance crews repaired the damaged sewer lateral, resolving the sewer backup problem.

Risk Management has carefully reviewed the damage claim submitted by the Envoy Condominium HOA, and reached agreement for settlement of the claim for the sum of \$9,476.88.

8. FINANCIAL IMPACT

Approval of the settlement would result in a payment of \$9,476.88 from the liability fund.
