ORDINANCE No. 186510

* Authorize a Cooperative Agreement with Northwest Youth Corps to sponsor a NWYC Community Conservation Corps team in Parks & Recreation for a total of six weeks from April through September 2014 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. NWYC Community Conservation Corps (CCC) program engages young adults ages 18-24 to work on priority resource management projects in their local communities, while receiving training, career development assets, earning a living allowance, and an AmeriCorps education award. This is an AmeriCorps program.
- 2. The NWYC crews will be involved in training, through this training they will perform some peak load work that Portland Parks & Recreation (PP&R) would otherwise not be able to do. Portland Parks' resource management projects include: vegetation maintenance, street tree maintenance, and natural surface trail maintenance.
- 3. PP&R is interested in engaging in this partnership since it will develop individuals who will have qualifications for future City employment.
- 4. PP&R administers its own programs fostering environmental education and natural resources work experience in young people the GRUNT (Greenspaces Restoration & Urban Naturalist Team) program and the Youth Conservation Crew. The program manager at NWYC has offered to hold a few positions on this NWYC crew for graduates from the PP&R GRUNT and YCC programs.
- 5. Pursuant to the NWYC Cooperative Agreement, attached as Exhibit A, NWYC will provide Portland Parks & Recreation-City Nature with a CCC team for a total of six weeks of resource management field work scheduled between April and September 2014.
- 6. The established total cost for the six weeks is \$25,000 for April through September 2014.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Director of Portland Parks & Recreation is hereby authorized to execute an agreement with NWYC, in substantially the same form as Exhibit A attached herein and as approved as to form by the City Attorney, for the purpose described in Section 1.
- b. The Mayor and the Auditor are authorized to provide payment in the amount of \$25,000, chargeable to the applicable budgets when demand is presented and approved by the appropriate authorities.
- Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists in order to avoid further delay in the

commencement of the services to be provided by the NWYC CCC; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
