

ORDINANCE No. 186511

Authorize a contract and provide for payment for the construction of the Sellwood-Moreland Sewer Rehabilitation Project No. E10333 for \$7,500,000 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. Approximately 31,500 feet of public combined and sanitary sewer in the Sellwood and Moreland neighborhoods is severely deteriorated and needs to be replaced.
2. Environmental Services has prepared plans, specifications, and cost estimates, and has obtained permits and temporary construction easements for replacing the deteriorated sewer pipe, including manholes, street inlets, and service laterals.
3. The estimated cost is \$7,500,000. Level of confidence is high. Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FY 14-15 Budget, Bureau of Environmental Services, WBS Element E10333.C60.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Commissioner in Charge is authorized to advertise a contract for the purpose described in Section 1, with the lowest responsive bidder.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the Sewer System Operating Fund Budget when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.


