7. BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS

There are currently two vacancies on the Business License Appeals Board due to the expiration on December 31, 2013 of the terms of Dharam Yadav and Harry "Ray" Jordan. Both Dharam Yadav and Harry "Ray" Jordan have agreed to be reappointed to the Board.

The Board position held by Dharam Yadav is to be appointed by the Mayor. If reappointed, his term would expire on December 31, 2016 (three years). The Board position previously held by Harry "Ray" Jordan is to be appointed by the Mayor. If reappointed, his term would also expire on December 31, 2015 (two years).

Portland City Code section 7.02.295 D requires that appointments to the Business License Appeals Board be made to provide an appropriate level of expertise in accounting methods and tax regulations. The two potential appointees meet the qualifications required by the code and should serve both the public and the City of Portland well in any matters coming before the Board.
