TO THE COUNCIL:

The Chief Procurement Officer has advertised and received bids for Bid Number 116383 for the Rose City Park Sewer Rehabilitation Project for the Bureau of Environmental Services, with a project construction estimate of \$6,410,000.00. The Bureau of Environmental Services rated the project estimate confidence level as High.

Bids were opened on February 20, 2014, and four (4) bids were received. The low bid of Canby Excavating, Inc. was deemed responsive to the requirements of the solicitation, and it is recommended that their bid be accepted at the unit price quoted in their bid for a total estimated amount of \$6,011,000.00.

The Bureau of Environmental Services along with Procurement Services, identified seven (7) Divisions of Work as potential M/W/ESB subcontracting opportunities for this project, resulting in \$1,377,882.00 awarded to subcontractors.

The Divisions of Work identified were:

Asphalt Paving	Concrete Cutting	Concrete Work	Excavating	Hauling Services (Trucking)
Sewer/Water/Storm Drain Work	Traffic Control Services (Includes TPDT)			

In their bid Canby Excavating, Inc. indicated their intent to self-perform the following divisions of work:

Excavating	Hauling Services (Trucking)	Sewer/Water/Storm Drain Work	Traffic Control Services (Includes TPDT)	
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MWESB participation represents 3.3% or \$45,000 of the estimated subcontracting dollars.

- MBE - \$45,000.00 performing Concrete Cutting

Canby Excavating, Inc. has committed to working with the City of Portland to attain its MWESB participation aspirations on the Rose City Park Sewer Rehabilitation project, and has submitted a plan outlining additional good faith efforts they will engage in to increase participation. After Canby Excavating, Inc. was found responsive to this bid and a Notice of Intent to Award a Contract was issued. Canby Excavating, Inc. subsequently increased MWESB participation by 17% or \$290,000.00 for a total of \$335,000.00 of the estimated subcontracting dollars bringing their MWESB participation up to 20%.

Canby Excavating, Inc. has a current City of Portland Business Tax Registration and their EEO Certification is current through October 10, 2015. The company is located in Canby, Oregon, and is not a State Certified M/W/ESB Contractor.

Canby Excavating, Inc. is in Full Compliance with the Equal Benefits Program.


Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FY 2014 Budget, Bureau of Environmental Services, WBS Element E10345.

It is further recommended that a Performance Bond and a Payment Bond each in the amount of 100% of the contract amount be furnished by the Contractor.

It is also recommended that a two (2) year Maintenance/Warranty Bond for 20% of the final contract amount be furnished by the Contractor before final payment is released.

The bid sureties of the remaining bidders should be returned immediately in compliance with Section 5.34.410D of the City Code.


