## ORDINANCE No. 186520

Authorize Intergovernmental Agreement with Portland State University for traffic safety research, evaluation and communications (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. By the authority granted in ORS 190.110 and 283.110, state agencies may enter into agreements with units of local government or other state agencies for the performance of any or all functions and activities that a party to the agreement, its officers, or agents have the authority to perform.
- 2. In consideration of the mutual promises and covenants contained herein, the Portland Bureau of Transportation (PBOT) and Portland State University (PSU) hereto establish a collaboration to perform traffic safety research and evaluation. This collaboration will improve the effectiveness of PBOT's transportation services.
- 3. The performance of traffic safety research and evaluation is consistent, compatible, and beneficial to the academic role and mission of PSU.
- 4. The primary goals of this collaboration are to achieve the following:
  - A. Provide resources for research activities and evaluation related to traffic safety.
  - B. Use PSU's expertise in Communications, Transportation Engineering and Urban Studies to provide a cost-effective means by which PBOT can improve the safety performance of the City's transportation system.
  - C. Combine the experience of public-sector practice with PSU's academic expertise to develop a strategic approach to transportation safety management.
  - D. Provide internship opportunities for those interested in the field of Transportation Engineering and Urban Studies.
  - E. Contribute to student development by providing enhanced educational opportunities in the field of Communications, Transportation Engineering and Urban Studies.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. The Commissioner-in-charge and the City Auditor are authorized to approve an intergovernmental agreement with Portland State University for communications, research, and evaluation services related to traffic safety, in substantially the form of the attached exhibit for this purpose.


