ORDINANCE No. 186527 As Amended

Approve the designation of three trees as City of Portland Heritage Trees and remove the Heritage Tree designation from fifteen trees. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Section 20.40.150 of the City Code provides for the listing, designation and maintenance of Heritage Trees within the City which, because of their age, size, type, historical association or horticultural value, are of special importance to the City.
- 2. The Heritage Tree Committee has inspected and evaluated three significant Portland area trees nominated for inclusion in the Heritage Tree program. The Committee has presented its findings to Portland's Urban Forestry Commission, which unanimously recommends that Council designate these trees as City of Portland Heritage Trees.
- 3. Section 20.40.150 of the City Code further instructs that "Upon unanimous recommendation of the Urban Forestry Commission, the Council may remove the designation of any tree as a Heritage tree if it finds that such designation no longer is appropriate." The City Forester and staff determined the trees listed below required removal and this action will reconcile the 2013 Heritage Tree list with current designations.

NOW, THEREFORE, The Council Directs:

- a. Under the provisions of PCC 20.40.150, the following three trees are designated as Heritage Trees and are included in Portland's Heritage Tree Program:
 - 1. Aesculus hippocastanum, common horse chestnut at 4741 SE 36th Place
 - 2. Fagus sylvatica, European beech at 1357 SW Spring Garden Street
 - 3. Tilia tomentosa, Silver linden at 408 N Rosa Parks Way
- b. Under the provisions of PCC 20.40.150, Heritage Tree designation is removed from the following fifteen trees because the trees no longer exist:
 - 1. Pinus coulteri, Coulter pine at 5306 SE 37th Ave designated in 1994
 - 2. Quercus palustris, Pin oak at 3527 SE Ankeny St designated in 1996
 - 3. *Quercus bicolor*, Swamp white oak at West Burnside and NW 19th Ave designated in 1994
 - 4. Araucaria araucana, Monkey puzzle at 3223 NE 13th Ave designated in 1995
 - 5. Magnolia fraseri, Frazer magnolia in Sellwood Park designated in 1995
 - 6. Castanea sativa, Spanish chestnut at 3435 SW Hood Ave designated in 1995
 - 7. Acer saccharinum, Silver maple at 2105 SE Taylor St designated in 1996
 - 8. *Tilia platyphyollos*, Bigleaf linden at 2343 NW Irving St designated in 1996

- 9. Magnolia tripetela, Umbrella magnolia at 1174 SE 53rd Ave designated in 1996
- 10. *Ulmus glabra 'Camperdownii'*, Camperdown elm at 5432 SE Hawthorne Blvd designated in 1997
- 11. Gymnocladus dioica, Kentucky coffeetree in Laurelhurst Park designated in 1997
- 12. Acer saccharinum, Silver maple at 3605 NE 18th Ave designated in 1999
- 13. Ulmus minor var. vulgaris, English elm at 704 NW 21st Ave designated in 1999
- 14. Ulmus ammericana, American elm at 625-635 NW 21st Ave designated in 1999
- 15. Ulmus ammericana, American elm at 625-635 NW 21st Ave designated in 1999
