Item 299 Ordinance to approve the designation of three trees as City of Portland Heritage Trees RE: and remove Heritage Tree designation from eighteen trees.

After approval by the Urban Forestry Commission, the Chair of the Urban Forestry Commission's Heritage Tree Committee questioned the accuracy of the list of trees recommended for Heritage Tree designation removal at City Council on April 2, 2014.

Therefore until confirmation of the Heritage Trees removed under the authority the City Forester, the three following listed trees are requested to be withdrawn from the ordinance:

Acer macrophyllum, Bigleaf maple at 2381 NE Davis St designated in 1997 (numbered 10) Quercus garryanna, Oregon white oak at 4825 SW Dosch Park Lane designated in 1997 (numbered 12) Ulmus X hollandica 'Hollandica', Dutch elm at 704 NW 21st Ave designated in 1999 (numbered 15)


