ORDINANCE No. 186528

Authorize a sole source agreement with SeaWestern, Inc., for the purchase of individual facepieces for firefighter self-contained breathing apparatus (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. On July 25, 2012, City Council passed Ordinance 185519, authorizing Portland Fire & Rescue (PF&R) to apply for the 2012 Assistance to Firefighter Grant (AFG) for the purchase of individual facepieces for firefighters Self-Contained Breathing Apparatus (SCBA).
- 2. On May 31, 2013, the Federal Emergency Management Agency notified PF&R that it was awarded, \$518,240 through the 2012 AFG, for the purchase of SCBA facepieces. The grant required a match of \$129,560, for a total project amount of \$647,800.
- 3. On July 17, 2013, City Council passed Ordinance 186161, accepting the AFG award.
- 4. City of Portland Code 5.33.120 authorizes the City to award a contract without competition as a Sole Source Procurement based on written findings that support the conclusion that the Goods and Services are available from only one source.
- 5. On September 30, 2013, pursuant to City Code 5.33.120.C public notice was posted on Procurement's eBid site with a written determination that the Mine Safety Appliances Company (MSA) Self-Contained Breathing Apparatus facepieces, including Heads-Up Display is available from only on source, SeaWestern, Inc. The seven (7) day protest period passed with no comments or protests received. PF&R currently uses MSA SCBAs, including facepiece.
- 6. Efficient utilization of existing equipment requires the acquisition of compatible equipment.
- 7. MSA has authorized SeaWestern, Inc., as its sole supplier of SCBA and parts in the State of Oregon.
- 8. PF&R needs to purchase 747 SCBA facepieces in order for all firefighters to have the increased protection of individually assigned facepieces. The total purchase price will be \$720,644.
- 9. This is a sole source contract and the competitive requirements of PCC 5.33.120(A) and the Goods and Services Manual are being waived.
- 10. The estimated cost is not to exceed \$720,644. \$518,240 will be covered by the AFG grant. Funds are available in the PF&R Stations Operations FY2013-14 Budget for the match and additional costs.

- 11. PF&R seeks the Council's authorization to enter into a contract with SeaWestern, Inc. for the purchase of MSA Self-Contained Breathing Apparatus facepieces, including Heads-Up Display, of approximately \$720,644 by adoption of this ordinance.
- 12. The Purchase Order will contain the following language: "This order is entirely contingent upon the successful approval by the NIOSH of NFPA 1981, 2013 edition certification of SCBA facepieces AND the full delivery and acceptance of this order by August 31, 2014 by Portland Fire & Rescue in order to meet the 2012 Assistance to Firefighters Grant award requirements.

This purchase order is void if these aforementioned conditions are not met."

NOW, THEREFORE, the council directs:

- a. The Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to enter into the contract on behalf of the City for the purposes identified in Section 1.
- b. The Commissioner and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver check(s) payable to the successful contractor chargeable to the appropriate authorization and accounting center when demand is presented and approved by the proper authorities.
