## ORDINANCE No. 186529

\* Amend Intergovernmental Agreements with regional partners to spend down reprogrammed FY2011 Urban Areas Security Initiative grant funds for equipment, training, planning, exercise and operational needs (Ordinance; amend Contract Nos. 30002299, 30002187, 30002131, 30002186, 30000150, 53129 and 30002298)

The City of Portland ordains:

## Section 1. The Council Finds:

- 1. The Department of Homeland Security provided financial assistance to selected urban areas through the FY2011 Urban Areas Security Initiative (UASI). The City of Portland, in cooperation with regional partners (TriMet, Port of Portland, Multnomah, Clackamas, Washington and Columbia counties of Oregon and Clark County, Washington) was granted financial assistance to address the unique equipment, training, planning, exercise and operational needs of the region. The City of Portland Bureau of Emergency Management (PBEM) administers the Grant for the region.
- 2. In support of Grant administration, PBEM enters into routine intergovernmental agreements (IGA) and amendments with regional partners to provide them with access to Grant funds.
- 3. The Department of Homeland Security has authorized an extension of UASI FY 2011 grant No. 11-170 to allow for reprogrammed funds to be used for the purchase of equipment and regional projects through July 31, 2014.
- 4. The execution of IGA amendments for this extension would be most efficiently performed if delegated to the Director of PBEM.

## NOW THEREFORE, THE Council Directs:

a. The Director of PBEM may execute IGA amendments to extend UASI Grant No. 11-170 with Clackamas County, Clark County, Columbia County, Multnomah County, Washington County, the Port of Portland and TriMet for the purpose of administering reprogrammed funds through July 31, 2014.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because the City's ability to perform the activities authorized by the grant within the required timeframe could be jeopardized by delay. Therefore this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
